- Entry Fee - \$25 per calf entered by December 15. \$30 per calf entered after December 15, 2011
- **No refunds!**
- Contest will be broken down by weight and breed for steers –heifers shown by age and breed
- This show will be divided according to [sanctioned rules](#). The British division is for **British Straightbreds only**
- Calves entered must be accompanied by a current health certificate; heifers must be vaccinated for Brucellosis
- **Warm washing facilities will be available**
- Overnight housing on Wednesday, but **no** night watchman on duty
- All entries must be weighed by 9 am on December 29
- All decisions of Show Committee and Judge will be final
- Calf Show Committee will not be responsible for accidents
- Calves must be born in 2011
- Only wood chips may be used
- All bedding must be cleaned or forfeit premium
- Listen to Brookings Radio or check KELO Closeline for cancellation information in case of bad weather

RULES AND REGULATIONS

NO livestock or equipment admitted in the arena prior to 9:00 a.m., Wednesday, December 28, 2011.

1. Entries open to any current 4-H member from Brookings. Members must be at least 8 years old by January 1, 2012. Entries must be received by Thursday, December 15, 2011.
2. Ownership as described in the 4-H State Fair book will be followed.
3. Heifers and steers will be shown in different divisions. Each breed will be shown separately, following South Dakota Junior Point Show Association rules. A champion for each breed within the division will be selected.
4. Show order will be as follows:
 - a. **BROOKINGS COUNTY SHOW**
 - i. Novice Showmanship – 8, 9, & 10 year olds (as of January 1, 2012) or 1 or 2 years of showing.
 - ii. Junior Showmanship. A champion and reserve will be chosen.
 - iii. Heifers by class and age groups followed by champion selection.
 - iv. Steers by class and weight groups followed by champion selection.
 - v. Senior Showmanship. A champion and reserve will be chosen.
 - b. **OPEN SHOW**
 - i. Show open to the world.
 - ii. Contest will be broken down by weight and breed for steers – heifers shown by age and breed
 - iii. This show will be divided according to [sanctioned rules](#). The British division is for British Straightbreds only. Shorthorns must present red registration papers.
 - iv. Calves entered must be accompanied by a current health certificate.
5. Registration fee is due with the pre-registration entry. **NO REFUNDS**
6. Weigh in on Wednesday night, December 28 from 6-9 pm or Thursday morning, December 29 from 7:30 – 9 am.
7. Registration from 7:30 – 9:00 a.m. on December 29 in the Swiftel Holding Barn. Open show registrations accepted until 9 am.
8. All animals must be halter broke, able to lead and tie.
9. Livestock Judging Contest, 4:00 p.m. Wednesday, December 28. Awards for the high junior and senior judges. No blowing or clipping allowed during the judging contest.

10. Trailers MUST be moved immediately after unloading animals. It blocks other people trying to unload animals.
11. Payback to top 5 breeding heifers and market calves.
12. No pets allowed in Swiftel Holding Barn (i.e. dog, cat...).
13. One fitting chute per family will be allowed.
