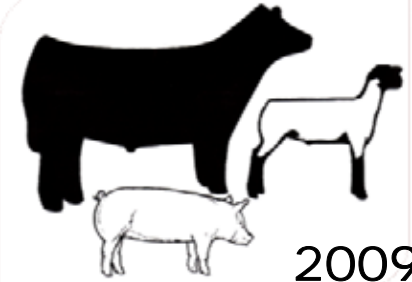

---Prospect Gilts (under 230)

---Market Gilts (230 and above)

---Prospect Barrows (under 230)

---Market Barrows (230 and above)

To qualify for Champion awards in the market division hogs must weigh 290 or under.

\*All hogs will be shown by breeds

**Each breed with at least five head in the division will have their own class; all others will be shown as Other Pure Breeds.**

\*Division Champions \$100, Reserves \$50

\*Breed Champions \$50, Reserves \$25
